

Welcome to Grubstake's Aurora Transportation Auction! If this is your first time bidding the following should be a good primer to introducing you to the Aurora Auctions, as they're a bit different than what you may have witnessed or seen on television.

Preview:

1. The vehicles are available for preview at 2530 E. 79th Ave, which is off 79<sup>th</sup> avenue and Lake Otis. Preview is held the Friday before the auction from 12:00 Noon Until 4:00 P.M. Vehicles are available for mechanical inspection, and if the vehicle is being sold with a key, you may start them
2. The actual auction is held at our offices at 2132 N. Post Road. We are in the large red building on the south side of Post Road, directly in front of Steelfab. We project images of the vehicles to a screen and you can bid to the auctioneer. Alternatively, if you cannot make the auction, you can bid online at [www.grubstakeauction.com](http://www.grubstakeauction.com) If you intend to bid online, please skip to #6.

Auction:

3. The first step that's required is registering for a bid card. You will need a valid government issued ID with a photo. Our staff will input your information and hand you a bidder's card with a number. This is what you will wave or hold in the air when you wish to make a bid. If you lose your bid card during the auction, please notify one of our staff immediately.
4. To bid, wait until the vehicle you'd like to buy comes up. The auctioneer will began chanting values (don't worry, he speaks clearly and we have a microphone system so you'll know exactly what number he is on) when he calls out a number that you'd like to bid, raise your hand or bid card. The auctioneer will then ask for a higher bid from the rest of the crowd. If another person bids, keep raising your hand until you've either won the vehicle, or been outbid. If you win the vehicle, the auctioneer will say "SOLD!" and repeat your bid and your bid number which will be recorded.
5. After you've won your vehicle, you can proceed to checkout, which is in the same area as registration. When you get to the counter, one of our staff will ask your bid card number so we can give you your total. Please note: there will be 10% or \$25.00, whichever is greater, added to your total in the form of a "Buyer's Premium." For example: if you buy a vehicle for \$100, your total will be \$125; if you buy a vehicle for \$1,000, your total will be \$1,100.

6. We only accept cash for the Aurora Transportation auction. All purchases must be paid in full by 1:00pm on the day of the sale. Any vehicles not paid for by 1:00pm will incur a \$25 late fee. Any vehicles not paid for by 2:00pm on the day of sale will be reauctioned at a later date.

7. Once you've paid for your vehicle, you will receive an "Impoundment Bill of Sale." DO NOT LOSE THIS PAPERWORK as there is a \$300 fee to get a new Bill of Sale. You will then have to take the vehicle and the "Impoundment Bill of Sale" as well as any letters attached to the Bill of Sale, to the DMV, or a DMV partner who will inspect the vehicle and verify the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) matches the Bill of Sale. Once this has been complete, you will get a Title with your name on it. Some vehicles have current registrations, but others will need registration. You can complete this at the DMV during the VIN inspection.

8. Tell all of your friends and family about the great deal you got at Grubstake Auction!

#### FAQs

Q: What do the different abbreviations like DUI, NO INS and SCOFF mean?

A: These are the reasons the vehicle was impounded. Here is a chart outlining the most common reasons.

<b>DUI</b>	<b>Driving Under The Influence</b>
<b>DWLRS</b>	<b>Driving With License Revoked or Suspended</b>
<b>NO INS</b>	<b>Driving Without Insurance</b>
<b>NO DMV</b>	<b>Driving without registration or title</b>
<b>SCOFF</b>	<b>Scofflaw - multiple unpaid tickets</b>
<b>SK</b>	<b>Safekeep - impounded at request of police</b>

Q: What is a Buyer's Premium?

A: A Buyer's Premium is a tool used by auctioneers to help defray the cost of the auction. At the Aurora Transportation auction, there is a 10% Buyer's Premium, with a \$25 minimum charge.

Q: When can I get my car?

A: You can pickup your vehicle once you've paid for it and have your receipt. You must remove the vehicle by 3:00pm on Saturday or make arrangements with Aurora.
